- Rationale: End of Course testing errors which also resulted in no building APR being released at this time.

# MSIP 5 2017 APR Status Levels

*Of the 553 traditional public school districts and charter public schools with an APR, scores ranged from 38% to 100%, with an average of 89.8%.*

- Accredited Range  $>70\%$  of points
  - (98.7% of Districts in Missouri)
- Provisional Range  $>50\%$  to  $69.9\%$  of points
  - (1.3% of Districts in Missouri)
- Unaccredited Range  $< 50\%$  of points
  - (0% of Districts in Missouri)
